The Mifflin House in Hellam Township, York County, built approximately 1800 was a safe house of the Underground Railroad through the late 1850s. It has been recognized by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. This significant property is threatened with demolition by the current owners and the Kinsley Corporation of York.
